WORSHIP THIS SUNDAY... Welcome to worship at Morningside Presbyterian Church. Please complete the information in the Friendship Pad at the end of the pews and pass the pads down and back again during the *Concerns* portion of worship. Worship notebooks and books for children are located in the library. Nursery for infants and toddlers is in Room 105; 2 year olds are in Room 012. Children ages 3-10 are invited to leave after the *Peace of Christ* for special classes: Threes, fours, and fives-Room 011; K-2nd grade-Room 003; 3rd-5th grade-in Room 001.

SERVICE MUSIC... The German hymn *Komm, heiliger Geist, Herre Gott*, comes from a 12th century chant *Veni Sancte Spiritus*, and was arranged as a chorale by Martin Luther around 1524. Usually sung as an introtit to invite the Holy Spirit into the hearts of the faithful, today this tune is sung during Pentecost. This beautiful, florid tune, brilliantly ornamented by Dieterich Buxtehude, begins with an opening soprano line ascending the first note of the tune inviting the Holy Spirit to enter our worship space. Nicolas de Grigny (c.1672-1703), a loved composer of the French Baroque organ tradition, was known for his setting of the Catholic Mass in 5 hymns. This setting of *Veni Creator Spiritus* comes from his collection *Premier livre d'orgue* originally published in 1699. The genre *En taille à 5* indicates that there are 5 voices with the tune in the *Taille* or tenor voice. The long pedal notes sing the tune over the ornamented filigree.

PENTECOST BANNERS

We recognize Pentecost as the beginning of Christ's church. Titled "Anointing Power", the pair of banners at the front of the sanctuary make use of batik fabrics in red, gold and yellow. The movement in the fabrics conveys the power and energy of the Holy Spirit coming upon the apostles and tongues of fire inspiring and enabling the start

of the church. This Living Spirit that moved on that first Pentecost continues to move in our midst and in our souls across all boundaries and throughout all time.
