Please note that the activity fee for three-year-olds and PreK has been rolled into the monthly tuition. In past years, this fee was paid separately from tuition.

An advance tuition fee is due on March 15, 2013 in order to hold a space for your child for the 2013-2014 school year. This payment is applied to the May 2014 tuition.

There is a limited amount of financial assistance available. Applications for financial assistance are available from the Director and will be reviewed on a case by case basis by the Preschool Committee.

CLASS INFORMATION

Toddler Class

Child must be 15 months old by September 1. Toddler classes meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Two-year-old Class

Child must be two years old by September 1. Two-day two-year-olds meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Three-day two-year olds meet Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Beginning in October, two-year-olds have the option to stay for lunch, provided by the parents, until 1:00 p.m.

Three-year-old Class

Child must be three years old by September 1. Three-day three-year olds meet Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Five-day three-year-olds meet Monday through Friday from 9:00 to 1:00 p.m. Both three-day threes and five-day threes have time for lunch, provided by the parents.

Pre-K Class

Child must be four years old by September 1. Pre-K classes meet Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. This includes time for lunch provided by the parents.

REFUND OF FEES

I understand that the registration fee is non-refundable and that advance tuition fees are refundable only if all three of the following conditions are met:

- the child moves out of the school area,
- Morningside Presbyterian Preschool is notified by July 1, 2013, and
- the space is filled by another student
